## **Directions for Using PAYROLL GIVING CARD**

Section One: This section authorizes payroll deduction. Fill out the requested information (Be sure to circle number of your pay periods). An "X" has been placed in the United Teachers Educational Foundation box under the "New" column for you. Write in the amount (We suggest \$10) to be donated each pay period, write your signature, and date your signature. LAUSD will not payroll deduct less than \$2 per pay period. If you would also like to donate to other causes, place an "X" in the "New" column opposite the charity, and write in a per pay-period amount.

Section Three: This section enables you to designate the specific recipient of your contribution within the purview of the agency designated in Section One.
